SWEETWATER VALLEY CIVIC ASSOCIATION MINUTES OF BOARD MEETING—State of Bonita August 2, 2017

CALL TO ORDER: The meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m. by President Michael Seiler at the Bonita Library Community Room. He welcomed everyone to the meeting, with special recognition to County Supervisor Greg Cox, his staff, and other attending County leadership.

ELECTION OF OFFICERS: President Seiler listed the current board members willing to fulfill office responsibilities; he then called for nominations from the floor. There being none, the current slate of officers have been re-elected for the 2017-2018 term:

STATE OF BONITA—SAN DIEGO COUNTY SUPERVISOR GREG COX:

Supervisor Cox welcomed attendees, introduced his staff members and told us their responsibilities. He then introduced several County Department Heads with a brief explanation of their respective areas of responsibility.

The Supervisor, as always, presented County achievements, highlighted national recognition awards, and discussed future County plans and ideas with a great deal of enthusiasm. Locally, we will see the children's section of the Library greatly expanded, completion of the Glen Abby Trail, and a horse crossing at Summit Park. We also heard about the next phase of construction in National City as the County moves forward to completion of the 24 mile Bayshore Bikeway as well as a proposed bike skills park to be built on County property just south of Summit Park at the intersection of San Miguel and Proctor Valley Roads.

Supervisor Cox also detailed the Bonitafest schedule to include:

- September 15th Twilight Trail Parade with a 5 p.m. gathering time at Sunnyside Arena, 6 p.m. parade start time.
- September 16th Bonitafest Performing Arts Festival at Bonita Vista High School from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.
- September 27th is opening night for the Bonitafest Melodrama at Sweetwater Community Church starting at 6 p.m.
